

Southern California Edison Fellowship AY2017-18

Purpose

The University of California, Merced is committed to the recruitment, admission, and retention of a high quality graduate student population. The Southern California Edison Fellowship is intended to support Ph.D. students in the STEM fields.

Eligibility Requirements & Standards

- All Ph.D. students are eligible, regardless of citizenship.
- Only Ph.D. students in a doctoral program with a research interest in a STEM field (see attached specific list)
- Good academic standing, enrolled in 12 units and GPA above 3.0.
- Awardee information may be shared with Southern California Edison, including but not limited to: name, award amount, UCM email address and program/research interest.
- Fellows are not permitted to hold employment during the tenure of this award.

Financial Support

 Recipients will receive a fellowship for one or more of the following semesters/terms, as follows:

^{*}Summer awards will disburse after the spring semester/term to support the student over the months of June, July & August.

 The submitted personal statement should include the requested semesters/terms of support, indicating priority for one or two semesters/terms. Only in rare circumstances will a fellow receive support for all three semesters/terms.

Student Loan Impact

Per federal guidelines, all fellowship and tuition support is taken into consideration when
determining student loan eligibility. If the student will receive federal student loans during the
same academic year as this award, please note that this award could, and most likely will,
reduce their student loan eligibility.

Award & Review Procedures

- Apply by completing an online application at https://gradopportunities.ucmerced.edu/grad
- Each application must include a one-page personal statement that speaks to how this award will help the student achieve their research/educational goals.
- Must include at least one letter of support from a UCM faculty member.
- Must include unofficial UCM transcripts.
- Applications are due by **Monday, August 14, 2017**, including the letter of recommendation.
- A special SCE committee of faculty will review all complete applications. However, please note, incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
