

Special Score Reporting Schedule

for the GRE® revised General Test

For tests administered between August and November 2011

What you need to know

Applicants who take the GRE® revised General Test between August and November 2011 will receive their score reports on a special score reporting schedule. This period allows for the necessary statistical analysis required for transition to the new 130 – 170 score scale.

Detailed Score Reporting Schedule for the computer-based GRE® revised General Test

Scores for tests administered between August and November 2011 will be sent to institutions as follows:

| Test Dates | Score Report Mailing Dates* |
|-----------------------------|------------------------------|
| Aug 1, 2011 - Sept 8, 2011 | Nov 8, 2011 |
| Sept 9, 2011 - Oct 2, 2011 | Nov 10, 2011 |
| Oct 3, 2011 – Oct 15, 2011 | Nov 17, 2011 |
| Oct 16, 2011 - Nov 18, 2011 | Dec 1, 2011 |
| Nov 19, 2011 – Nov 28, 2011 | Dec 8, 2011 |
| Nov 29, 2011 or later | 10 – 15 days after test date |

^{*}Approximate mailing dates.

Starting in December 2011, score reporting for the computer-based test will return to the regular reporting period of 10 to 15 days after the test date.

Score reports for paper-based administrations will continue to be reported six weeks after the test date.

Applicants who need their GRE® scores before November 2011 should take the GRE® General Test before August 2011.
