Since 2002, Lim has curated over 50 history exhibits and edited more than 10 books published by the Merced County Historical Society. Some of the titles include: Greetings from Fountain City: Historic Postcards of Merced, Cooking in Merced County: A Taste of History, and Grazie America: From Italy to Merced County.

In addition to being a museum professional and local historian, Sarah has taught at California State University, Stanislaus. She is a regular contributor to the Merced Sun-Star where she writes the Museum Notes column about local history. Sarah collaborates with local historical societies for the preservation and promotion of local history and is a frequent speaker to local service clubs.
